December 15, 2025

The Swayzee Town Council Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Aaron Travis, President.

Present were Aaron Travis, President, Rhonda Fagan, Heather Zirkle, Mike Horsley and Tyler Bundrick, Town Board Members.

Also in attendance were Desiree Arenas, Clerk Treasurer; Jake Simpkins, Utility; Kyle Persinger, Town Attorney and Josh Miller, Town Marshal.

Aaron Travis led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Aaron Travis made a motion to accept the October 20, 2025 Regular Meeting Minutes. Tyler Bundrick seconded the motion. The motion was approved with a vote of 5-0.

Water

Amanda Trakas with Alliance Indiana Water and myself have been working on updating the well head protection for Swayzee. I will present this to the board when it becomes available.

Sewer

The sewer plant seems to be operating properly.

Two contactors at the lift station had gone bad and were replaced by Huston Electric on 12/5/2025.

Attempted to install the comminutor at the sewer plant, but we have a sump pump that is stuck in the pipe that the comminutor sits in so American pump will return to get that out and install the comminutor.
