The Trail Creek Town Council met in regular session on Tuesday September 17, 2024, at 7:00 p.m., at the Trail Creek Town Hall, 211 Rainbow Trail, Trail Creek, Indiana. Mrs. Heath, Council President led the pledge of allegiance. Council Member Christopher Ott was not in attendance.
