AN ORDINANCE PARTIALLY REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 3 OF 2020

Ordinance No. 4 of 2020

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Winamac, Indiana (the "Town Council"), is responsible for the performance of various functions for the Town of Winamac (the "Town"); and

WHEREAS, Town Council previously passed Ordinance No. 3 of 2020, An Ordinance Declaring a Local Disaster Emergency and Promulgating Mitigation Procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council is now desirous of repealing Section I, Paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, of Ordinance No. 3 of 2020, while leaving Section 1, Paragraph 6, in place; and

WHEREAS, despite the partial repeal of Ordinance No. 3 of 2020, the Town reserves the right to continue to monitor the spread of the Novel Coronavirus (Covid-19) within the local and surrounding communities, and promulgate additional mitigating procedures, as necessary to protect the health and safety of the businesses and residents of the Town, subject to state and federal orders and declarations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council of the Town of Winamac, Indiana, that Section 1, Paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, of Ordinance No. 3 of 2020 is now repealed, as of the date of the passage of this Ordinance.
