CENTER TOWNSHIP OF MARION COUNTY, INDIANA
COMMUNITY SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered this 22nd day of December 2025 by and between CENTER TOWNSHIP, MARION COUNTY, INDIANA (“TOWNSHIP”) and MAPLETON-FALL CREEK DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION an Indiana non-profit corporation (“CORPORATION”);

WHEREAS, IC 36-6-4-8(b) provides that with the consent of the township legislative body, the executive may contract with corporations for health and community services not specifically provided by another government entity; and,

WHEREAS, Corporation is an Indiana non-profit corporation engaged in providing the health and/or community services that are not offered by another government entity; to wit: providing resources, support, and advocacy to help individuals and families overcome barriers and thrive.

WHEREAS, the Township finds that the citizens of the Township are in need of the services offered by Corporation and that there is no other government entity that is designated to provide those services

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to enter into a community services contract with Corporation to provide the described health and/or community services to the citizens of Township;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Corporation shall provide the health and/or community services described herein to the citizens of Township
2. In consideration for the provision of the health and/or community services provided herein, the Township shall pay to Corporation, the sum of one thousand dollars and zero cents (\$1,000.00), which shall be payable by check by the Corporation submitting an invoice to the Township.
3. Corporation is an independent contractor and is not performing the health and/or community services as an agent of Township. Corporation agrees to indemnify and hold Township harmless from any claims, actions or causes of action, including reasonable attorneys’ fees and costs of defense, that may be

brought against Township arising from or relating to the services provided by Corporation.

4. Corporation shall acknowledge and give due credit to the Township in its publicity, interviews, advertising, news releases, and fiscal reports.

5. Corporation shall provide a detailed report by January 31, 2026, listing the expenses disbursed for residents of the Township under this contract.

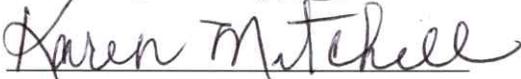

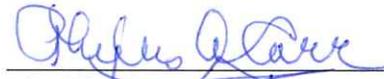
