### **Meeting minutes**

**May 20, 2025**

Decatur Township Board chair Josh Masquelier called the meeting to order at 6:04 pm.

Pastor Tim Lindsey led the prayer

Secretary Jared Bond led the board in the pledge of allegiance

Chair Masquelier introduced resolution 2025-05 ‘Selection of a developer’ and motioned to vote on it last

Chair Masquelier motioned to approve previous meeting minutes

Chair Masquelier motioned to move resolution 2025-03 to amend the township assistance guidelines to a future meeting
