Opening a money market account with money in excess of monthly operating expenses was discussed. The Clerk was instructed to obtain the necessary information to determine monthly operating expenses and send this to the Board by email.

A motion was made to review the CD amounts and to obtain quotes on interest rates in order to reinvest in CDs for the same two funds. In addition to the CDs, a money market account is to be opened at the same time with money in excess of monthly operating expenses as approved by the Board subsequent to this meeting and as amended to these minutes.

Township Board of Luce Township, Spencer County Resolution 2024-003

A Resolution Regarding the Personnel Policy of the Township

Whereas, Amended State Examner Directive 2018-1, dated October 30, 2023, requires that Townships have a written personnel policy; and

Whereas, the Township Personnel Policy is to be uploaded with required annual uploads into the Indiana Gateway for Government Units beginning with the annual 2023 annual uploads and in future years if uploaded; and

Whereas, SBOA recommends as a best practice that the township board review and, if appropriate, record its approval of such a policy;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Township Board of Luce Township, Spencer County, as follows:

Section 1. The Luce Township Personnel Policy, is as follows:

Compensation: All compensation must be set out on Township Form No. 17, Resolution Establishing Salaries of Township Officers and Employees. Form No. 17 is to be adopted as a part of the budgeting process, and with the exception of elected officials, may be amended at any time, subject to budgetary limitations.

Employee Benefits, Leave, and Overtime: This policy makes no provision for employee benefits, leave time or overtime compensation.

Record of Hours Worked: Per IC 5-11-9-4, record of hours worked by employees will be maintained on General Payroll Form No. 99A, Employee's Service Record.

Nepotism: All employment must comply with the Nepotism Policy approved by the Board.

Section 2. The Township Board approves the policy as stated in Section 1.

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-004 RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE CREDIT LINE OF THE VISA BUSINESS CREDIT CARD ACCOUNT HELD BY SPENCER COUNTY BANK

- 2. That the two-thousand dollar (\$2,000) increase be added to the Visa credit card held by the Township Clerk, Linda F Garrett (8722) increasing the limit on this card to three thousand dollars (\$3,000).
