*This request is made pursuant to IC 5-14-1.5-5. This statute requires 48 hours notice (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays) be given to the public and specifically to news media that request such notice in writing prior to January 1.*

*Please respond to this letter either by mail or email by Jan. 1, 2026 so that we can confirm your receipt of this request and verify which entities will be covered by this letter. Receiving this letter does not mean notices were not received in the past. This is a letter we send out annually as a reminder. We print Tuesday and Saturday. Deadlines are 1 p.m. on Monday for Tuesday publication and noon on Friday for Saturday publication. Notices may be emailed to [newsroom@washtimesherald.com](mailto:newsroom@washtimesherald.com).*
