



7. Held two 'ISC Days' at the Indiana State Capitol to raise awareness of the ISC during the Indiana Legislative Session




Voyageur Ancient Fife and Drum Corps -

★ ISC GRANTS ★



ISC "Seed Grant" of \$10,000 was provided by the America 250 Foundation. The 2023 and 2025 Indiana Legislative Sessions have provided the ISC with State administrative grants to support efforts. The first was through the IDVA for \$125,000 in 2023. The second is through the IDNR for \$250,000 in 2025.

Edward D. Pullen, Veteran of WWII and the Korean War, Age 98 of Marshall County Indiana.

Edward is a direct decendent of Captain John Pulling, a Boston Merchant, member of Boston's Committee of Correspondence, close friend of Paul Revere and Vestryman of the Old North Church in Boston.

John Pulling was the person who lit and hung the two lanterns in the steeple of Old North Church.

'One if by land and two if by water'


