### **III. Approval of Minutes from July 28, 2022 Meeting**

Committee members were provided a copy of the Minutes prior to today's meeting. Judge Mullican made a motion to approve the Minutes; Traci Lane seconded the motion. Committee members approved the July 28, 2022 meeting Minutes unanimously. Judge Felix and Nikki Ford were not yet present via Zoom for voting.

### **IV. Presentation on Data Evaluation vs. Research**

Dr. Aalsma shared a PowerPoint presentation called "Data Considerations for Research and Evaluation for Justice-Involved Youth." The presentation addressed drivers of recidivism and methodological issues related to data. It also highlighted some existing research projects related to juvenile justice data. The presentation will be sent to members following the meeting. Further considerations are needed regarding retrospective data vs. prospective data, as well as identifying clear questions with a limited scope.

### **V. Review of Data Work Group Time and Task Plan**

The committee reviewed the "Data Working Group Overview, Deliverables, and Timeline" document and discussed ideas for future work. Two sub-workgroups were established to review existing definitions and policies/protocols around data collection and quality assurance:

- (1) Definitions: Matt Aalsma, Nancy Wever, Judge Felix, and Kristi Bruther
- (2) Policies/Protocols: Matt Aalsma, Nancy Wever, Kaitlyn Christian

Lisa Thompson will circulate a Doodle poll to all members to find a time for both groups to meet before the next Data Work Group meeting. Each group will provide a report of their findings at the October meeting.

Dr. Aalsma clarified for the group that he sees Goals 2-5 as "retrospective" data initiatives where the workgroup can rely on existing work, but improve the data quality and build upon what we already have. In contrast, Goals 6-7 are seen as "prospective" and allow the workgroup to establish what should be seen in the future.

Existing initiative resources to look at include Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative (JDAI), Racial and Ethnic Disparities (RED) Reporting, Supreme Court's Probation Quarterly Reports, Log of Juveniles Held through the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute (ICJI), Odyssey, Quest, and Supervised Release System (SRS).

Dr. Aalsma and Mary Kay Hudson will meet to work on a broad goals statement and objectives to propose to the Work Group at the October meeting.
