Discussion on Missing Pieces

- What are the priorities for our recommendations?
 - Could our mission be to deliver local (county-wide) and regional (multiple-county) assessments, diagnostic testing, and treatment, therefore keeping a child out of the formal system when referrals are coming from schools/parents/churches/law enforcement, before any formal or informal entering into the juvenile justice system?
- What agencies need to be responsible for overseeing justice-involved youth?
 - O Who is already doing this well?
 - o How or when do agencies need to collaborate?
- Can a short-term goal to create a multidisciplinary team be implemented?
 - o What funding might be needed?
- How and when can diagnostic assessments be done via telehealth?
 - o Who will oversee the assessments?
 - o Where is it housed?
 - o How do you access it, and by whom? How quickly is it accessed?

- o What is the method of oversight (virtual or in-person)?
- o What funding might be needed?
- What do you do when a child is detained and there is a need for an assessment and treatment plan to prevent re-offending and/or handling a severe emotional or behavioral challenge?
 - O Does this approach change for small counties?
- What are the demographics of the justice-involved youth?
 - o Where are they coming from (geographic)?
 - o Who is not receiving care?
 - o Are there trends in the gaps in service?
- What is the benefit of our proposed model as opposed to the old model?
 - o What changes in legislation, if any, might be needed?
 - What role, if any, should YJOC play after the report is submitted to accomplish recommended actions?
- Is there a proposed timeline for implementing the recommendations?
