1. The meeting was called to order at 1:06 pm.

- 2. The Work Group reviewed and approved the minutes from the November 13, 2024, March 26, 2025, and May 28, 2025 meetings.
- 3. Katie Schwartz, IU School of Medicine, presented the data compiled by the Data Work Group. Looking at data quality. The WG is currently conducting phase 2 of the project. Phase 2 will be a deep dive into diversion, specifically data from SRS and Quest. The amount of data available for Phase 1 varied significantly from jurisdiction to jurisdiction. The compiled data shows wide variation in diversion practices among the jurisdictions, suggesting diversion trends in each jurisdiction have a significant impact on data collection practices.
- 4. The Work Group is no longer required to meet in person and will meet via Zoom unless otherwise indicated. A couple of members have left the Work Group. The Work Group will explore adding new members in the future and will continue to meet annually unless otherwise needed.
- 5. The Indiana Youth Diversion Program Directory is not ready for the Work Group's review yet, but should be ready before our next scheduled meeting in November.
