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Trauma-informed care shifts the conversation away from “What’s wrong with you?” to “What happened to you?”

The trauma-informed framework is the lens through which the entire organization views itself and provides services to the community.

It becomes a strength-based perspective by which we understand maladaptive or unhealthy behavior as adaptations for survival, rather than as personal shortcomings.

Trauma-informed care shifts the conversation away from “What’s wrong with you?” to “What happened to you?”

When we shift the focus, we are changing how we think about and view the people we serve, ourselves, and each other.

This is the big paradigm shift at the foundation of trauma-informed care.

You are more than what happened to you.
Keep reminding yourself about that.

This reframe gives you a new lens that all your interactions, policies, practices, and procedures are filtered through.

This different way of thinking moves away from the disease model to the strengths, resiliency, and wellness model.

The purpose behind this focus is to connect life events to current levels of functioning. This reframe can open a whole new world for service providers, the people you serve, and your staff.

It helps to change internal messages around perceived weaknesses and deficits.

**The message “I am broken and weak” can then become
“I am a survivor/thriver and very strong.”**

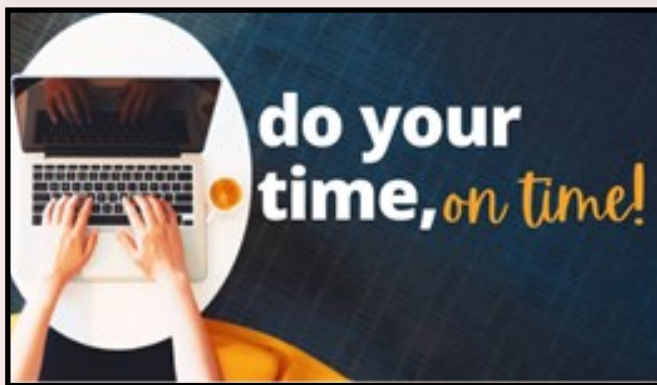


IDOH

As many of you are aware MSH reported a sentinel event related to falls in September 2021.

Looking at the summary data, falls were the number one reported sentinel event type in 2021.

As a result of increased falls at MSH in 2021, we will be developing and implementing a falls reduction program throughout the hospital.

January 2021, The Joint Commission added the following to the Sentinel Event chapter in the standards:

Fall in a staffed-around-the-clock care setting or fall in a care setting not staffed around the clock during a time when staff are present resulting in any of the following:

- Any fracture
- Surgery, casting, or traction
- Required consult/management or comfort care for a neurological (for example, skull fracture, subdural or intracranial hemorrhage) or internal (for example, rib fracture, small liver laceration) injury
- A patient with coagulopathy who receives blood products as a result of the fall
- Death or permanent harm as a result of injuries sustained from the fall (not from physiologic events causing the fall).
