- People ages 18-49 years: Those who received Janssen COVID-19 Vaccine as both their primary series dose and booster dose **may** receive a second booster dose using mRNA COVID-19 vaccine at least 4 months after the Janssen booster dose.
- People ages 50 years and older: **Should** receive a second booster dose using an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine at least 4 months after the first booster

[†]An **8-week** interval may be optimal for some people ages 5 years and older, especially for males ages 12–39 years. A **shorter interval** (3 weeks for Pfizer-BioNTech; 4 weeks Moderna) between the first and second doses remains the recommended interval for people who are moderately or severely immunocompromised; adults ages 65 years and older; and in situations in which there is increased concern about <u>COVID-19 community levels</u> or an individual's higher risk of severe disease.
