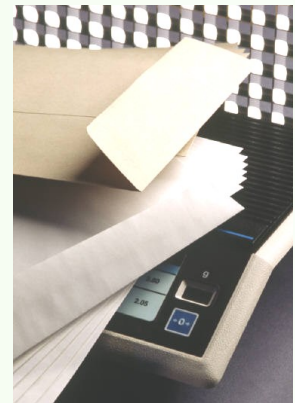

Gainwell Technologies to mail 2020 IRS 1099-MISC tax forms to providers

All Internal Revenue Service (IRS) 1099-MISC tax forms for 2020 related to Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) payments will be mailed and postmarked by January 31, 2021.

Please be aware that you may receive two forms associated with payments made under two different tax identification numbers in 2020. Payments were issued under the DXC Technology Services LLC tax identification number for January through September 2020. Payments were issued under the DXC MS LLC (Gainwell Technologies LLC) tax identification number for October through December 2020.

Note: If you were paid less than \$600 by either of the two entities, a 1099-MISC form will not be generated under that tax identification number.



IHCP to mass adjust professional and professional crossover claims that paid incorrectly

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) identified a claim-processing issue that affects certain fee-for-service (FFS) professional claims and professional crossover claims processed from February 13, 2017, through December 9, 2020. The claim-processing system did not correctly adjudicate certain claims for dually eligible IHCP members with both professional, and professional crossover claim types. Claims may have resulted in “duplicate payments” and both claim types may have paid.

The claim-processing system has been corrected. Claims processed during the indicated time frame that paid incorrectly will be mass adjusted. Providers should see adjusted claims on Remittance Advices (RAs) beginning March 3, 2021, with internal control numbers (ICNs)/Claim IDs that begin with 52 (mass replacements non-check related). If a claim was overpaid, the net difference will appear as an accounts receivable. The accounts receivable will be recouped at 100% from future claims paid to the respective provider number.

Changes to NCPDP Version D.0 Transaction Payer Sheet for electronic transactions

Recent updates to the *National Council for Prescription Drug Programs (NCPDP) Version D.0 Transaction Payer Sheet* provide guidance to the pharmacy industry during a declared emergency, such as the national public health emergency due to the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).

Effective immediately, fields in the *NCPDP Version D.0 Transaction Payer Sheet* have additional updates as shown in Table 1. These fields with complete descriptions *and* the updates below are in the Claim Segment, Pricing Segment, and Prescriber Segment sections of the transaction payer sheet.

IHCP to mass adjust claims for hospice services with retroactive rates

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) identified a claim-processing issue that affects certain fee-for-service (FFS) claims for hospice services when the nursing facility (NF) had a retroactive rate adjustment, for claims with dates of service (DOS) prior to February 13, 2017. Some claims may not have been adjusted appropriately.



The claim-processing system has been corrected. Claims processed during the indicated time frame that paid incorrectly will be mass adjusted. Providers should see the adjusted claims on Remittance Advices (RAs) beginning March 3, 2021, with internal control numbers (ICNs)/Claim IDs that begin with 52 (mass replacements non-check related). For claims that were underpaid, the net difference will be paid and reflected on the RA. For claims that were overpaid, the net difference will appear as an accounts receivable. The accounts receivable will be recouped at 100% from future claims paid to the respective provider number.

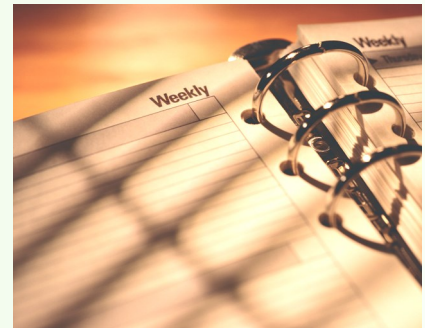
IHCP to host three webinars for updates on EVV implementation
