Division of Aging announces service additions to the A&D Waiver

The Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP) and the Division of Aging (DA) announce the addition of two services to the Aged and Disabled (A&D) Waiver:

- Caregiver coaching and behavioral management is being added to help equip the participants' lay caregiver with the skills needed to manage the individuals' medical conditions and health needs.
- Goal engagement is aimed to better engage participants to identify and address their goals through a set of individualized, person-centered services.



Effective date for the services in Table 1 will be available for reimbursement pending approval from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). Effective date To Be Determined (TBD) by CMS approval.

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Save the date for the 2022 IHCP Works seminar

The 2022 Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) Works seminar will be held Tuesday through Thursday, Oct. 11–13, 2022, at the Indianapolis Marriott East, located at 7202 E. 21st St. in Indianapolis.

The 2022 IHCP Works seminar sessions will include educational information presented from all IHCP partners, including the Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA), Gainwell Technologies, Anthem, Managed Health Services (MHS), MDwise, CareSource, and UnitedHealthcare. Topics from IHCP partners will include prior authorization, provider enrollment, and CMS-1500 and UB-04 claims, among others. FSSA sessions will include telehealth, managed long-term services and supports (mLTSS), electronic visit verification (EVV), the “Return to Normal” following the public health emergency and much more. Many sessions will allow time for questions following the presentation.

Guest room reservations made on or before Sept. 19, 2022, are available at a special rate of \$146 plus state and local taxes, per night.
