

Broadband

- \$250 million appropriation
 - \$203 million Capital Projects Fund
 - \$47 million from State Fiscal Recovery Fund
 - \$69 million remaining
- Federal Funding Transition
 - ARP/CPF → Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act Broadband Equity, Access and Deployment





ARP – State Fiscal Recovery Fund

Program Updates

- Infrastructure
 - Over 40 road and bridge projects
 - \$563 million obligated, \$155 million spent
 - Over 60 water, sewer, stormwater and drainage projects
 - All funds awarded; \$116 million obligated
- Next Level Conservation Trust
 - 27 projects, 3,700 acres, \$23 million matched by another \$9 million
- READI
 - Over \$200 million for 139 funding requests submitted



Several programs under evaluation; waiting on release of information

- Cybersecurity Preliminary Planning
 - Local government meeting
 - Met with 84 counties and remaining 8 are scheduled
 - 480 officials and representatives
 - Scoping for local assessments to determine needs and gaps
 - Office of Technology working with Purdue and IU
 - Federal funding estimated at \$20 million over 4 years; opened in September
 - Planning committee and charter development

- Office of Energy Development
 - Electric Grid Resiliency due March 2023
 - State Energy Program due December
 - Revolving Loan Fund details anticipated mid-November
- Housing and Community Development Authority
 - Weatherization plan submitted to U.S. Department of Energy

- Transportation
 - National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Plan
 - Approved by FHWA, September 27
 - \$100 million over 5 years
 - Invest in at least 44 charging stations along travel corridors



- Transportation
 - Bridges
 - \$74 million per year
 - Existing replacement and preservation program
 - Carbon Reduction
 - \$30 million per year
 - Required strategy development with MPOs
 - PROTECT
 - \$34 million per year
 - Resiliency to natural hazards
